

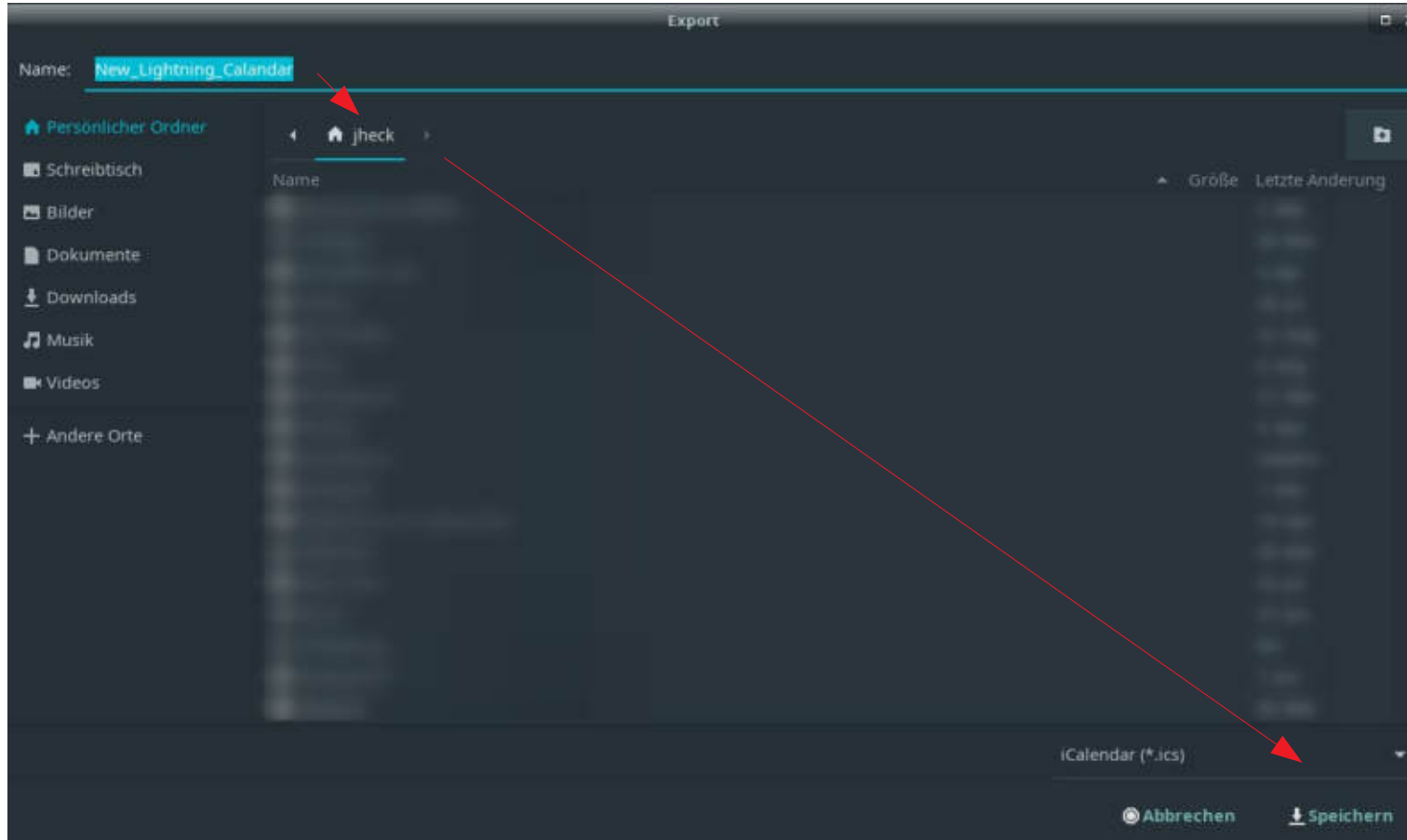


Select new calandar right mouse click and select export, that will generate an .isc calandar file what will be used from Lightning and Orage

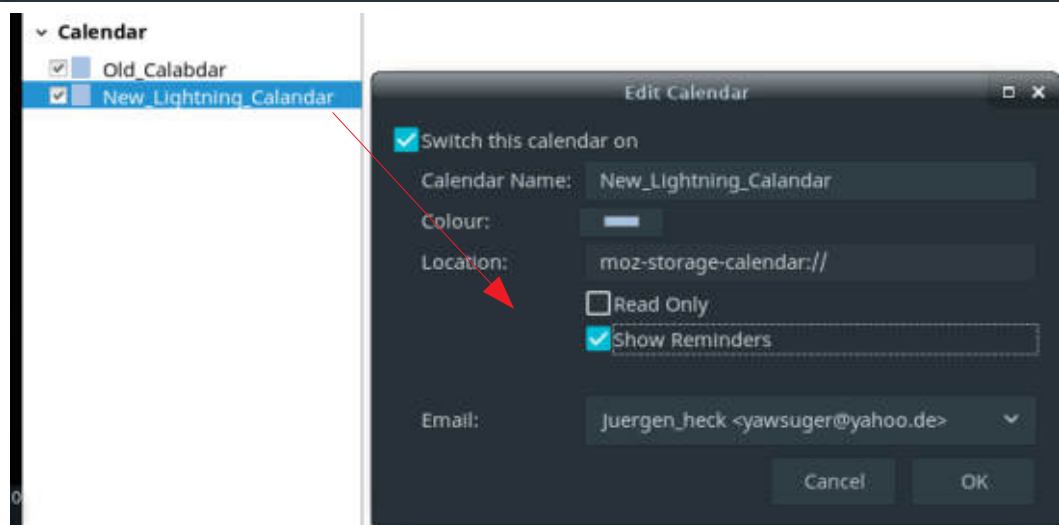
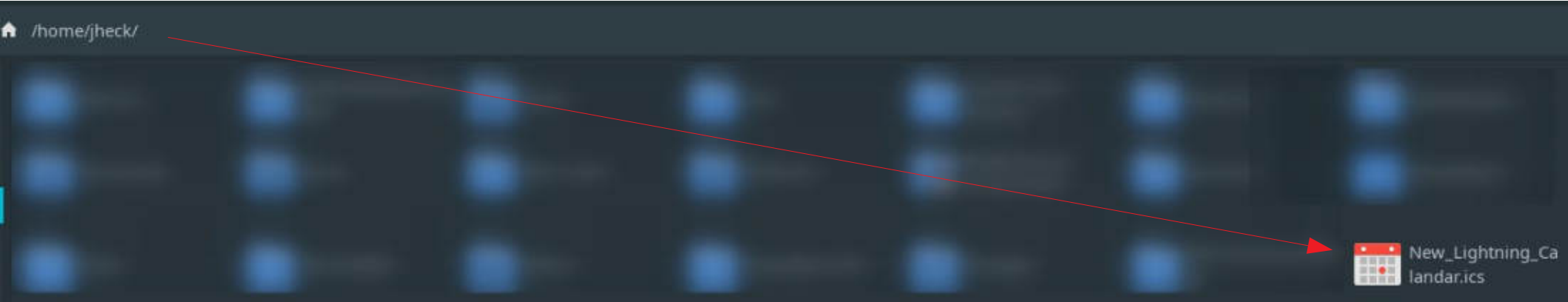

Now the New_Lightning_Calendar.ics is generated

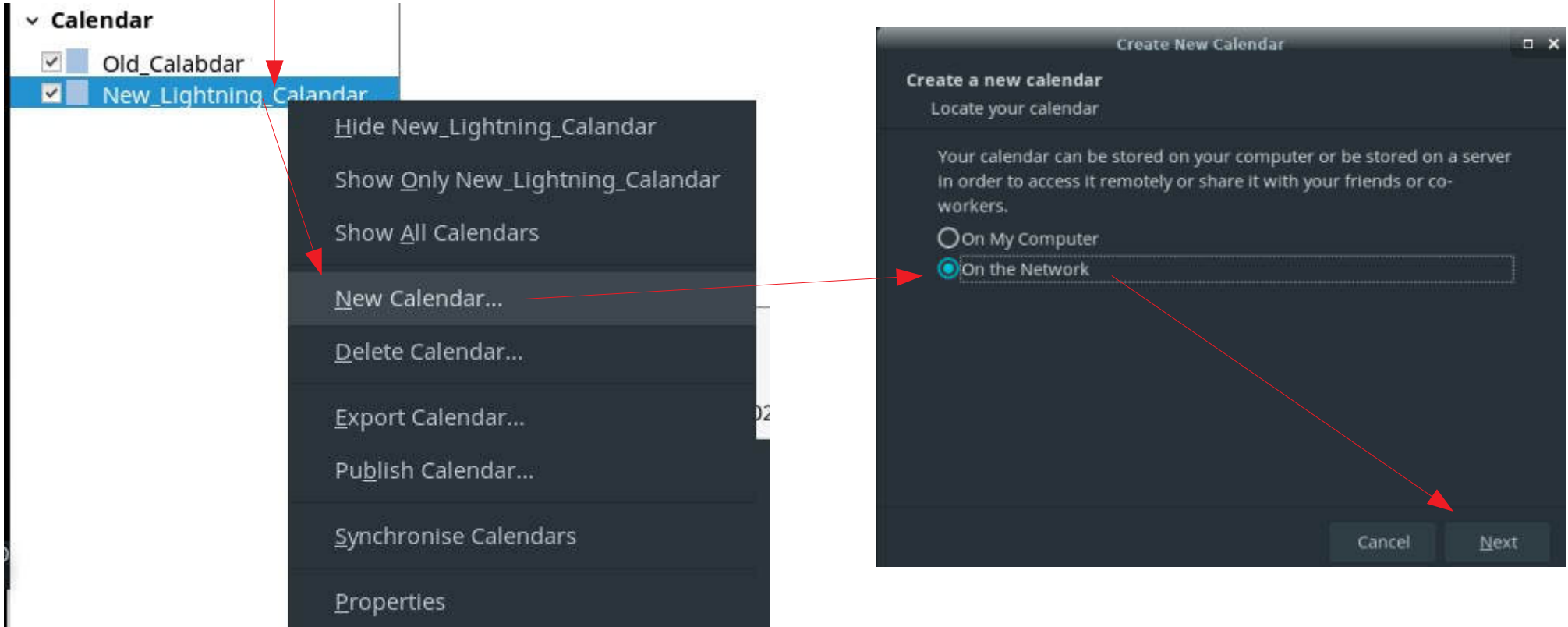


If you double click on the calandar in Lightning the you could see the actuall location is different to the exported one

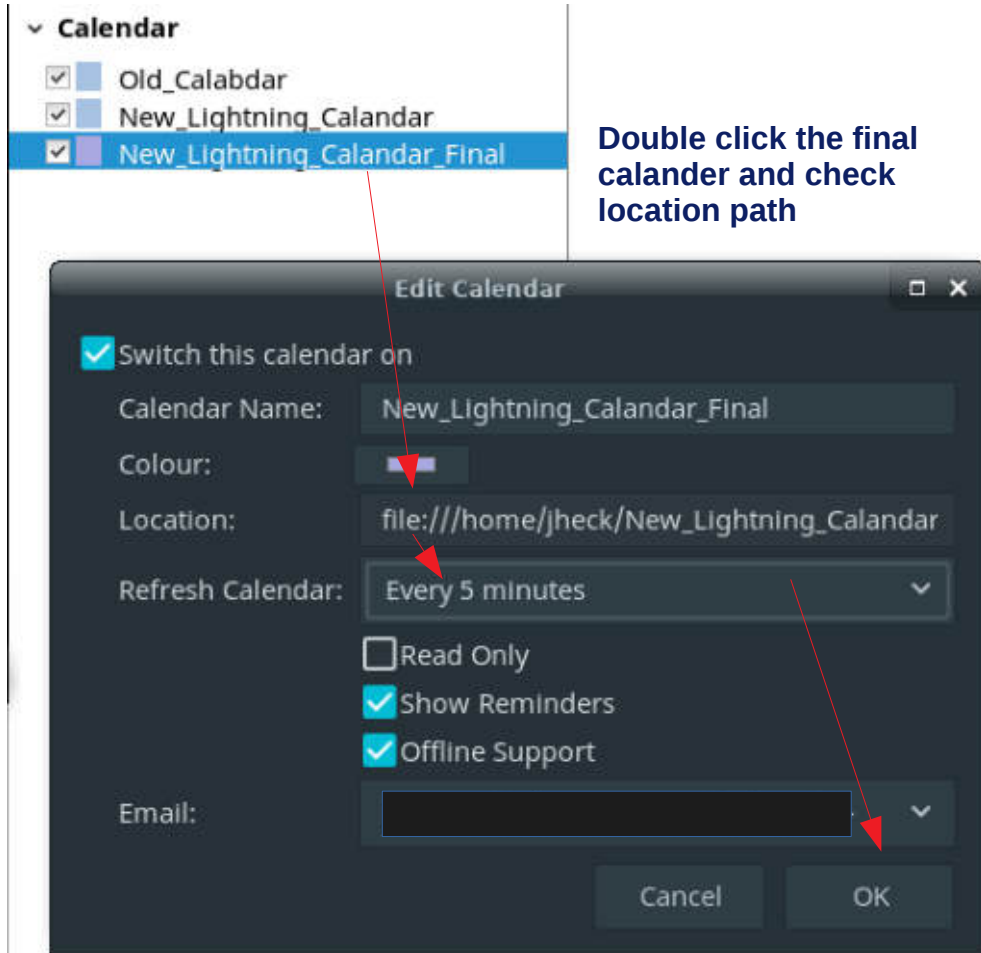
